Loans and Mortgages (KS5)

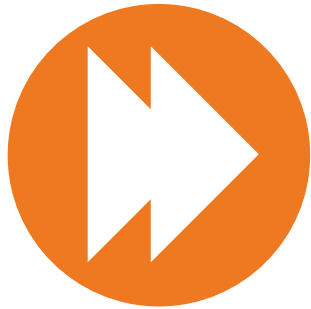
Learning Objectives:

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Discover Fortunes

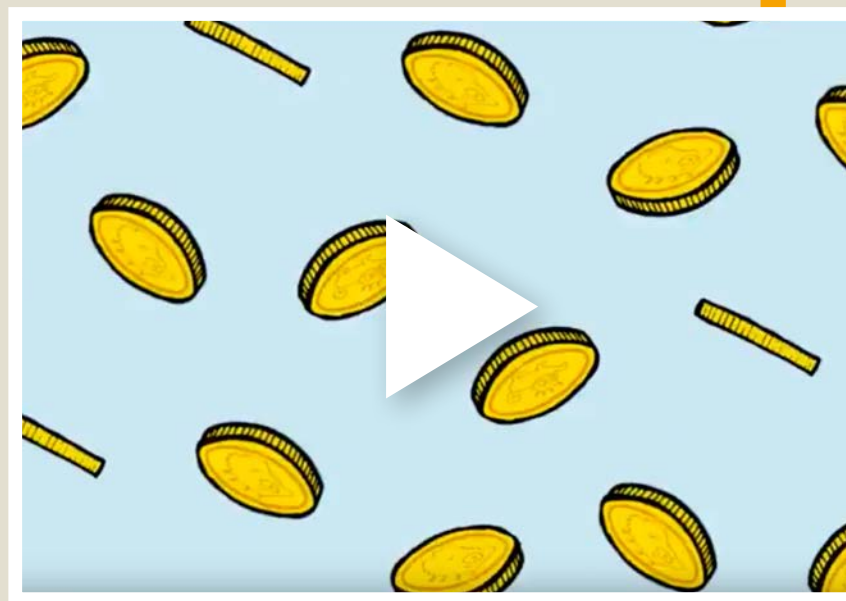
(estimated running time 60-90 minutes)
